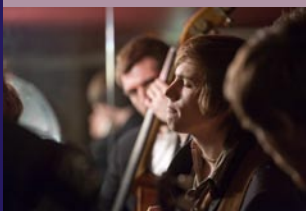
Connie Lush & Blues Shouter

John Etheridge rightly enjoys a glowing reputation throughout the jazz world and beyond and has been described by Pat Metheny as, "One of the best guitarists in the world".

Equally at home on electric or acoustic guitar he is a gifted and creative player whose approach to music can only be described as 'eclectic' as he refuses to accommodate, or even acknowledge, artificial musical boundaries. His range is well illustrated by his years of touring and recording with the iconic Stephane Grappelli while simultaneously doing likewise with the legendary jazz-fusion group, Soft Machine.

John has played with John Williams, Yehudi Menuhin, Dizzie Gillespie, Herb Ellis, Mundell Lowe, Nigel Kennedy, Pat Metheny, Birelli Lagrene, Barney Kessel, Vic Juris and countless others. His ability as an outstanding composer is sometimes overlooked but he is often under pressure from audiences to feature more of his own material.

Marcus Malone Band

Detroit- born, Rock/Blues guitarist, songwriter and soulful singer Marcus Malone is a heavyweight rock/blues musician, whose career has included a stint on UA/Capital records and Motown.

Often described in the music press as having a voice resembling the great Paul Rogers, Marcus has appeared at the Albert Hall with BB King, opened for Walter Trout, and headlined numerous festivals in the US, UK and Europe. His music is a mix of deep toned grooves ranging from heavy rock to soulful blues/rock ballads.

Marcus has a powerful band of musicians behind him in the form of Stuart Dixon, with his exhilarating solos and speedy licks and an equally hot rhythm section consisting of Chris Nugent (drums) and Johan Buys (bass).
